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Board of Nursing Online Renewal

Nurses licensed by the NM Board of Nursing may renew their license online using a **Visa** or **MasterCard**. Your credit card payment is processed as a secure, encrypted transaction for your protection. Holders of licenses that expire a month in rear are mailed a **License Renewal Notice** with your online Registration Code (Pin #).

***Please be aware online renewal fees are non-refundable. If you have questions about your eligibility for renewal please call board staff before renewing.*

Please note that you will need the following before beginning the online renewal process:

1. **License Number,**
2. **Registration Code** (Pin #),
3. **Credit Card**

You will need to click on "Register as a new user"

If you are a first time visitor to the Online Licensing site please [register as a New User](#) using your Registration code (Pin #) and License number as provided in your Renewal Notice. If you have already logged into the Online Licensing site and have established your user name and password continue to the [login page](#).

Apply for an Initial License or Certificate

Applicants applying for a *re-exam* must re-register as a new applicant with a new user id and password.

If you are a *Facility* license applicant or holder, please click [Here](#) to apply for or renew a facility license.

In order to apply for an initial/endorsement nursing license you must:

1. Register.
2. Add education information.
3. Complete a questionnaire.
4. Pay the fee ([Click Here to Review Fees](#)).

The application checklists and extra documents with instructions for your license type can be downloaded from [Online Application Documents](#) folder.

NCLEX Examinees - all documents specified in the [Initial Licensure Application](#) will need to be submitted before your application can be processed.

Renewals - Search for Existing License or Certificate

In order to renew an existing license or submit name and address changes, you must create a username and password and associate it to your records. This form allows you to search for your existing personal/professional records.

1. Enter your **entire** license number (ie "RN-12345" or "R98765") and registration code into the two fields below.
2. Press the **Search** button to search for your records based on the information you provided.

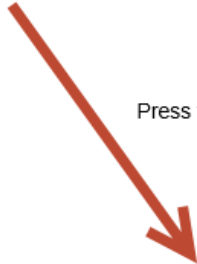

The New Mexico Board of Nursing offers licensees the opportunity to renew a license and update address information, via our new secure web interface.

If you are a new user, you will need to register with us to create a user id and password. You will use your user id and password to access the site each time you visit.

AS OF JANUARY 1, 2015, ALL EXISTING USER ID'S HAVE BEEN CHANGED TO THE LICENSE NUMBER FOR EVERY NURSE WHO HAS PREVIOUSLY REGISTERED. USE YOUR ENTIRE LICENSE NUMBER (ie "RN-12345" or "R12345") AND PASSWORD TO LOG IN.
